MINUTE ORDER. Defendant must make its first production by February 28, and continue to make rolling productions on the 28th of each month thereafter, processing at least 300 pages per month. With each release, defendant will provide the plaintiff with an index of non-responsive attachments. The next status report will be due on March 31, 2022. The Court understands the plaintiff's frustration, but it is not inclined to alter its ordinary procedures or summon the parties to the courthouse because the production in this case which was supposed to begin during the height of the impact of the omicron variant got off to a slow start.
